ANIMAL REGISTRATION RENEWALS DUE 10 APRIL

Dog and cat owners are reminded that animal registration payments need to be made by Thursday, 10 April.

Reduced registration fees are applicable for pets aged over 10 years; dogs kept for working stock; animals that are registered with an Applicable Organisation; and animals that are desexed.

Additional discounts also apply if the owner currently holds an eligible pension card. Payment can be made in person at Council's Customer Service Centres, by cheque or money order mailed to Council, over the phone by phoning (03) 5450 9333 or online via BPAY.
