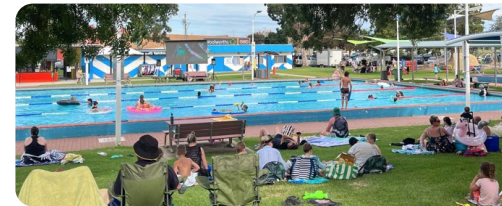

## SPEND YOUR SUMMER AT OUR OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOLS

The Cohuna and Kerang swimming pools are the place to keep cool this summer.

Extended opening hours will be in place from Sunday, 1 December – Friday, 20 December:

**Weekdays:** 3pm-8pm, with the waterslide open 4pm-6pm Wednesdays and Fridays.

**Weekends:** 10am-8pm, with the waterslide open 1pm-5pm both days.

Both pools will be closed on days the Bureau of Meteorology website's forecast temperature for Kerang is 23 degrees Celsius or lower.
